



ADHESIVE ARACHNOIDITIS (AA)

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NON-PRESCRIPTION ANTI-INFLAMMATORY AGENTS FOR SPINAL CANAL INFLAMMATORY DISORDERS (SCID)

SCID's include inflammation in or around these tissues: protruding (slipped) discs, Tarlov cysts, exiting nerve roots, cauda equina nerve roots, and arachnoid-dural covering of the spinal canal. New research shows that inflammation can spread to multiple tissues in the lumbar-sacral spinal canal just like cellulitis can spread on your arm or face. SCID may or may not be visible on an MRI or show elevated inflammatory markers in the blood. Consequently, we recommend that every person with a SCID or suspected SCID begin their treatment program as soon as possible with one or more, non-prescription medicinal agents that are available in health food stores or on the internet.

SOME COMMON SYMPTOMS OF SCID's

- Burning sensations
- Sensation of insects/water on skin
- Leg weakness
- Episodes of heat/sweating
- Pain in waves
- Fatigue
- Pain relief on standing/sitting
- Jerking/tremors of legs
- Bladder hesitancy or stoppage

SPINAL CANAL INFLAMMATION REDUCTION AGENTS

- Serrapeptase
- Andrographis
- Adrenal cortex
- Traumeel®
- Boswellia
- Curcumin/turmeric
- Palmitoylethanolamide (PEA)

All the above are non-prescription. Use two or three since different tissues may be involved with inflammation. These can be taken with all pain control medications.
